We can now welcome groups of up to 20 volunteers for a full or half day session at our premises in W10. We also have smaller sessions available in our regional hubs in Birmingham & Leeds.

A great opportunity to spend time together in an informal environment and to make a significant difference.

Your session will begin with a brief charity introduction before you work together to sort, curate and box donated books to be gifted to children throughout your region. We ask groups for a £35 donation per head, (with a minimum donation of £280 in London). This includes a presentation about our work. In London larger groups can opt to build and paint one or more of our Pop Up Book Huts as part of their day with us.
