The Children's Book Project is a grassroots charity, powered by volunteers at every stage of what we do. We need your help gifting 1 million preloved books to children that have few or none. At our three Book HQs in London, Leeds and Birmingham we would love you to join us as a book volunteer, working in our friendly volunteer team to sort and pack books.

Each session we host a group of corporate volunteers and during the course of their time with us they will quality control, organise, sort and box books for delivery. Your role will be to help them with these tasks, to help them understand the value of their contribution, and to help our team leaders run the day.

The role

On any typical day with us this role might include:

- Helping to set up for the day, greet volunteers and end of day tidying
- Instructing small teams of volunteers how to check, sort or box books
- Some standing and lifting
- Telling volunteers about our work and ways in which they can help further

Who are we looking for?

You might have an interest in our aims, in children's books or in volunteering within your local community. We are looking for people that enjoy communicating with others, working as part of a team and helping to make a tangible difference to the lives of children and young people across the UK.

The role can involve standing for periods of time so you should be mobile. You should have at least basic conversational English.



What we offer you

The opportunity to work as a fully supported, valued member of our team. Training, ongoing support and great communication. Regular socials with a group of fun, energetic volunteers of all ages.

Anticipated commitment

We run five volunteering days a week in London and 3 days per week at our Birmingham and Leeds HQs. We ask volunteers to join us twice a month to make the most of the volunteering experience.
